AUSTIN HOUSE

Austin House is a 5-minute walk from BTA's main campus in Hyde Park, Boston's southernmost residential neighborhood. Like the city, the newly renovated house retains the rich character of its hundred-year history and the style and comfort of every modern convenience. The location allows the five student residents to immerse themselves fully in the BTA experience.

House amenities included in fees:

- · A single or shared furnished bedroom
- Full-time live-in faculty to ensure safety at all times
- Faculty supervised study halls (Sun Thurs)
- Airport Pick up* (2 weeks notice required)
- Wifi
- Communal TV and study room
- · Bedlinen and towels
- · Weekly bathroom cleaning service
- · Weekly towel change service
- · Breakfast, lunch, and dinner
- On-site laundry

Austin House advances the school's commitment to global education by providing an immersive school experience in the comfort of a home-style residence. Students develop life-long friendships and gain the independence required to succeed in college and beyond.



The Austin House Academic Advantage: The house parent is a Faculty member charged with helping students settle into life at BTA.

They provide individualized attention, helping the resident integrate fully with the wider school community.

They work with the International Student Coordinator to help students manage their academic work, and provide the activities to enrich the student's experience of the city through weekend trips and activities.

Student Housing Important Notes Frequently Asked Questions

Important Note:

No Boston Trinity student is allowed to live independently, regardless of age. Students failing to comply with this requirement may be withdrawn from school.

What housing options do students have at BTA?

Students can live with

- A natural parent
- An approved BTA or agency homestay family
- · A school residential house

What are the different costs of housing?

- Homestay program + Insurance \$21,500
- Residence House + Insurance \$24,000

(Both options include the \$2500 program fee and \$2000 student health ins.)

How are spots assigned in the student residences?

Students are assessed for their suitability for residential life through the admission office. Spots are assigned to eligible students on a first-come basis, though priority is given to upper-classmen.
