School Supplies List

General Required Items

- Several pencils and a pencil sharpener (with a container to catch shavings - no electric sharpeners) OR several mechanical pencils with extra lead
- Eraser
- Highlighter
- Several black or blue pens
- 3x5 index cards (lined)
- Pencil box or zipper pouch to hold the smaller items above (recommended)
- Three ring binders (1") for organizing notes in each class
- File dividers
- 8½ x 11 lined paper (with pre-punched holes) for note taking in each class AND/OR notebooks with pull out lined paper with pre-punched holes for organization in a three ring binder.

- 3x5 index cards for vocabulary (*7th & 8th grade*)
- Blue or Black pen only (*no other colors*)
